Cosby, Tennessee – Smoky Mountain Llama Treks is proud to announce several recent additions to their llama herd.



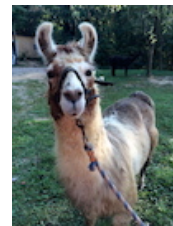
Kuzco
